## PVC PANEL MAINTENANCE



Abrasive cleaners and bleaches must NOT be used on PVC panels.

When fitting lighting if in doubt consult the lighting manufacturer.

DO NOT EXPOSE TO DIRECT SUNLIGHT, OR TEMPERATURES IN EXCESS OF 60°C.

The hard-wearing surface of the panelling can be hygienically cleaned with Anti-Bacterial Hard Surface Cleaner which is a mild NON-ABRASIVE cleaner, or domestic NON ABRASIVE WASHING UP LIQUIDS.

#### **HOW TO CLEAN PVC PANELLING** IF YOU DO NOT USE PVC **PANEL CLEANER**

#### Step 1

Create a solution of 1 tablespoon of Washing up liquid mix in with 1 qt. of warm water in a clean plastic Pail/Bucket. Thoroughly mix the solution.

#### Step 2

Wipe the PVC Panels with the solution using a microfiber cloth or sponge. Remove as much loose dirt and grime as possible. Frequently rinse the cloth with fresh water to avoid reapplying dirt to the PVC Panel.

#### Step 3

Rinse the PVC Panels with fresh water to wash away the soapy solution and loosened grime.

#### Step 4

Buff the Panels with a clean dry microfiber cloth to add shine and prevent soap scum.
